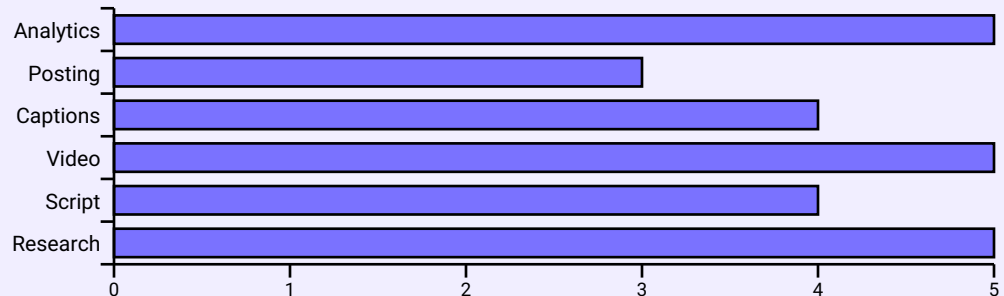

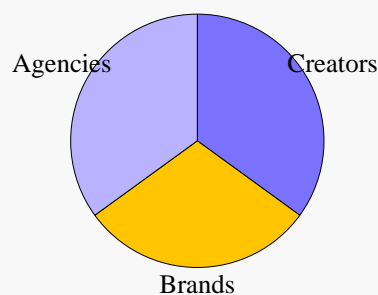
Analytics and optimization

Avoid automation for fake engagement, misleading endorsements, deepfake impersonation, false claims, mass comments, and low-quality spam posting. AI should support human-led strategy, not manipulate users or the platform.

Recommended safety checklist

- Review every script and final video before publishing.
- Label realistic AI-generated content when required.
- Check product claims, testimonials, and before-after visuals.
- Avoid using private figures, minors, or public figures in misleading AI content.
- Use official APIs and approved workflows when posting through software.

7. A Practical AI TikTok Agent Workflow

The safest and most effective approach is AI-assisted, human-approved. This keeps the speed benefits of AI while protecting brand quality and platform compliance.
